

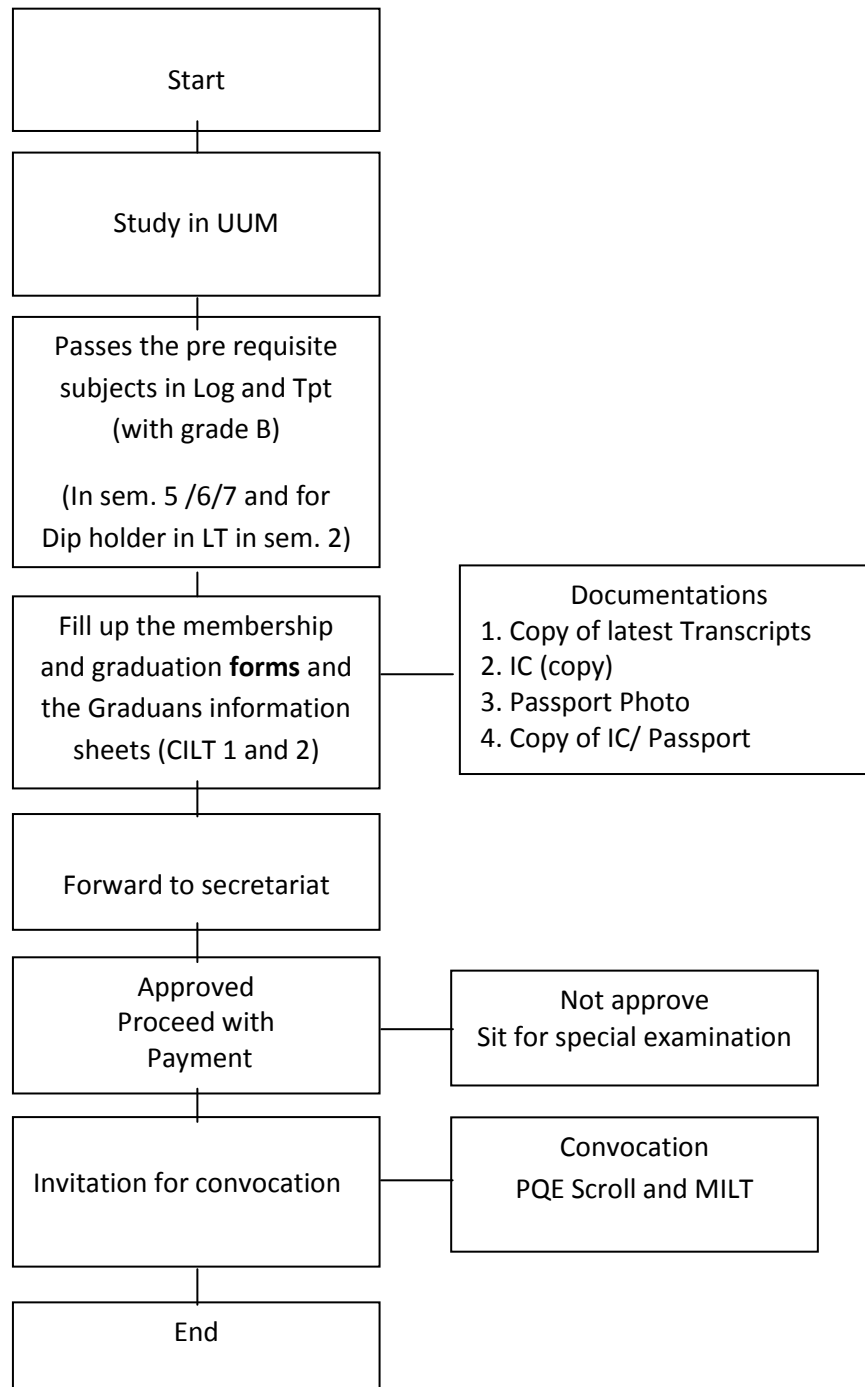

INSTRUCTION FOR GRADUANS FOR CILT CONVOCATION

1. Appropriate outfit – smart with lounge suit for men and decent dress for ladies - preferred white shirt and black /dark suits,
2. University will organise transport for the convocation, if students choose to travel by their own would kindly inform the secretariat and movement order or instruction shall be advised
3. University is organising the briefing for convocation and provide an invitation for those qualified
4. Graduates need to make final arrangement by contacting the secretariat if any shortcomings prior to convocation
5. Parent /guests will be under graduates' capacity and arrangement
6. The safety of personal belonging during the movement is under personal capacity
7. Any new information shall be informed from time to time by the leader or convoy commanders
8. Students' movements shall be in group any problems during the journey need to be informed
9. Should maintain the discipline as graduates and uphold the good name of the university
- 10 . No rejection or withdraw in last minutes after final submission of the form, and in-case of emergency and preferred cancellation, the administrative charges (20% out of the total costs) shall be imposed.
11. All graduates are compulsory to attend the convocation
12. The original scroll shall be given to all graduates in one month after convocation and can be obtained from secretariat.
13. The fee and the venue for convocation are differed from year to year and the university will provide breakfast, lunch and dinner for one day.
14. The convocation photos are available upon request.
15. The convocation date is normally being organised once a year in every November and the day is in Saturday . In any situation the university shall limit the number of students for joining the CILT convocation. Students are advised to reserve in advance starting from January to September together with the related forms and fee as required.

About Us

The Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport (CILT) is the international professional body for all sectors of the transport industry. Founded in the United Kingdom in 1919 and granted a Royal Charter in 1926, it was established to promote knowledge of the science and art of logistics and transport and to provide a source of authoritative views for communication to government, industry and the community.

The International Institute's Patron is Her Majesty the Queen of England.

The Institute is a progressive and purposeful organization which provides a forum for professionals and academicians engaged in transport & logistics industry, whether it is in planning, operation and management, logistics and physical distribution, industrial transport, transport technology or for those whose contribution to transport lies in the areas of education, research and associated activities.

The Institute's Qualifying Examinations are internationally recognised professional transport and logistics qualification of a high educational standard. A Member with a pass in the CILT Qualifying Examination is accepted as equivalent to a general degree. Together with appropriate work experiences, they lead to full Membership and the designatory letters of "CMILT" which is recognised by the Public Services Department in Malaysia as equivalent to an honours degree of a local university. Avenues for post-graduate studies in the logistics and transport field may be pursued at any local or overseas universities offering such courses.

The Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport in Malaysia (CILTM) had its beginnings in 1965 with the formation of Malaysia Section. This was to fulfil the need for the qualified locals in the field of logistics and transport after independence and the increasing demand in the transport industries. In October 1990, the Malaysia Section was upgraded to that of a National Council. Today, the situation in the logistics and transport industry even more dynamic and the demand for trained logistics and transport managers and operators is greater than ever.

Internationally, the institute has about 33,000 members with about half the number residing outside the UK, mostly in the Commonwealth countries. Malaysia has about 2,000 members of all grades.
